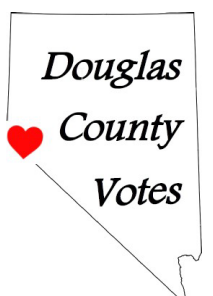

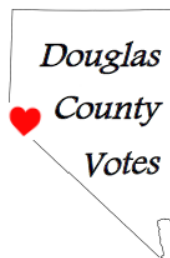

 Tuesday, February 6, 2024**



Active voters that have not opted out of receiving a mail ballot, can expect their ballot to be mailed no later than January 17, 2024.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are not affiliated with either the Democratic OR Republican political parties, you will NOT be mailed a ballot. If you wish to vote in the Presidential Preference Primary “PPP” election, you must update your registration status by selecting one of the major political parties.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY

- **January 9, 2024** – Close of voter registration by personal appearance (the 4th Tuesday preceding any election): Last day a person may register to vote by appearing in person at the Douglas County Elections Office. *NRS 293.560(1)(a)(1)*
- **January 9, 2024** – Close of voter registration by mail (the 4th Tuesday preceding any election): Last day a person may register to vote by mail (must be postmarked by this date). *NRS 293.560*
- **January 10, 2024 through January 23, 2024** – Updating voter registration information online or paper: After the close of registration for an election, a registered voter may **update** their voter registration information online through the Nevada Secretary of State: registertovote.nv.gov or a paper application. The County Clerk shall authorize at least one of the methods for a registered voter to update their voter registration information. *NRS 293.55832*
- **January 27, 2024 thru February 2, 2024** – Early voting period at the Douglas County Community Center ONLY.
- **February 6, 2024** – Presidential Preference Primary “PPP” Election.

PLEASE NOTE: If you are not affiliated with either the Democratic OR Republican political parties, you will NOT be mailed a ballot. If you wish to vote in the “PPP” election, you must update your registration status by selecting one of the major political parties.

Nevada currently maintains a closed Primary Election System. For the upcoming election, voters will receive a ballot based upon their current political affiliation (on record). Since primaries are nominating elections, voters who wish to support a major party candidate must be registered to that party.

Nevada EASE Voting

EASE (Nevada's Effective Absentee System for Elections) is an online application that seamlessly integrates voter registration and electronic ballot delivery and marking. EASE allows further independence and enables covered voters (Active Duty Military, elderly Voters with a Disability, or Tribal Voters who live on a colony or reservation) to register, request, mark and return their ballots from the comforts of their own homes. EASE is available for elections with a federal contest on the ballot 45 days before Election Day at NVEASE.gov.
